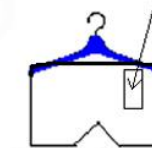
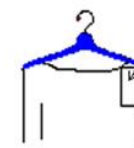
1. Consignors must bring a minimum of 15 items and will receive 65% of the selling price.
2. Consignors may shop the presale on Friday evening at 5:30 p.m. This time is for consignors only. One adult per pass. No children at the presale please. They are welcome the remainder of the sale.
3. Consignors will be given one guest pass. Guests may shop starting at 7:30 p.m.
4. An \$8.00 facility fee will be deducted from each consignor check.

## TAGGING GUIDELINES

**Cards:** 3 x 5 index cards or heavy cardstock if using a printer.

**Pins:** Medium to large safety pins. No clothespins!

**Hangers:** All clothing must be on hangers, no zip lock bags. Sets sell better than separates, so match things up when you can. Pin sets together on one hanger, with the pants or skirt pinned to the outside so both pieces can be viewed. (see illustration).

**Con #:** Make sure that your consignor number is correct and on every item you bring. Do not make corrections on your tags. Make a new tag if this is necessary. Double check at drop-off to make sure we have gotten your consignor number correct on all your bar code labels. Your profit depends on this information!

**Size & Description:** Please use a size and not S, M, or L. Give a short description on your tag in case it becomes separated from the item. Ex: "girl's blue Oshkosh jumper w/ print blouse" rather than just "dress" will help in matching items with lost tickets.

**Price:** You set the prices of the items that you bring. Price to sell! In order to make the most of our rack space, all hanging items must have a minimum price of \$3.00. If you do not feel your item is worth \$3.00, save it for a garage sale. Don't overprice--for clothing, we suggest at least 50% - 75% off of the original retail price, depending on name brand & condition. Big ticket items usually bring more of their original price. Please keep your prices in full dollar increments (no \$1.99, \$6.50, etc.). If you do not want an item to be sold for half-price, put the letters N.D. (for No Discount) in the lower right corner of your card.

**Items other than clothing:** Group small items together in a zip-lock bag. Pin your card to the outside of the bag. Blankets, sheets, even bibs and belts will sell better if you place them on a hanger. Attach shoes to each other with pins, or string and attach your 3x5 card to the shoes. Use clear packaging tape to attach cards to non-clothing items and to secure zip-lock bags so that small hands cannot reach in. Scotch tape will not hold and your tickets may become lost if not securely attached.

## ITEM GUIDELINES

Before you spend your valuable time tagging an item, please make sure it meets these guidelines.

### WE DO ACCEPT (UPDATED)

- Children's spring and summer clothing
- Infant clothing--priced competitively--it's abundant!
  - Limit of 10 pieces/sex in each size range
- Large children's clothing--it's also abundant!
  - Limit of 10 pieces/sex in sizes 14, 16, 18 & 20
- Maternity clothing - limit of 10 pieces
- Shoes in excellent condition - limit of 10 pairs total
- Baby equipment that is thoroughly cleaned
- Bedding - infant and juvenile
- Toys, books, games, etc
- VHS tapes with boxes – limit of 10
- Sports equipment/video equipment
- Children's furniture and layette items

### WE DO NOT ACCEPT (UPDATED)

- Out-of-date clothing
- Fall and winter clothing, junior or misses clothing
- Stained, torn, nappy or extremely worn items
- Items tagged incorrectly or hanging items priced less than \$3.00, clothing in zip-lock bags
- Underwear or socks unless brand new
- Tee shirts unless brand names or logos
- Drop-sided cribs
- Car seats manufactured before 2007
- R or Mature rated games or videos
- Stuffed animals unless battery operated or licensed characters
- Battery operated toys without batteries
- Bags of loose toys unless theme oriented (i.e. bags of all army toys, all Barbie toys, etc.)
- Baby equipment that is not clean or is recalled
- Used pacifiers/nipples, nursing bras, breast pumps

## DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP

### DROP-OFF PROCEDURE

1. Leave all items in your car, come to check-in desk.
2. Sign in and verify that your consignor # is correct.
3. Confirm or update your mailing information.
4. Sign the Wee Swap waiver.
5. Pick up shopping passes for you and your guest.
6. After completing these steps, bring all your items into the building. If needed, use a rolling rack for clothing which should be sorted by size and sex.
7. Once all your items are in, a Wee Swap worker will inspect them to make sure they are tagged and hung correctly and that they meet the Wee Swap guidelines. Items which do not meet these guidelines will be returned to you.
8. If you do not have barcodes on your tags, you will need to go to a barcoding station. There they will print a small sticker for you to attach to each of your tags. If you used our tagging program, or ordered barcodes thru the mail, (terrific time savers!) you may skip this step and begin putting items on the sales floor. Workers will be there to assist you.
9. Before leaving, stop and pick up any items which were returned to you at inspection. Items not retrieved will be donated to charity.
10. Begin telling everyone you know about Wee Swap! They might just purchase some of your items!

### PICK-UP PROCEDURE

1. Check in at one of the front desks. Sign in beside your consignor number.
2. While a worker retrieves your hanging items, please look in these places: lost ticket table and stained rack (items we have pulled after inspection).
3. If you brought any LARGE items, please ask our worker if you have any remaining to be picked up. They will be able to help you locate them.
4. Before returning to your car, please look through your items to make sure that they all belong to you.
5. Stop by the DONATE rack and leave what you can. These items are donated through a local church to area families. All are appreciated.
6. Go home and plan how to spend your check when it arrives!
